KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Support and assist campers (ages 8–17) through daily STEM and technology activities including coding, robotics, 3D Printing, Digital Animation, PC Building, and Adobe Creative Cloud
- Work as part of the camp team under the direction of the Team Leader, contributing to a safe, fun, and inclusive environment for all
- Assist with group transitions, activity set-up and clean-up, and material distribution throughout each session
- Engage warmly with campers and their accompanying family members, ensuring every person feels welcomed and included
- Capture daily photos and videos of camp activities on your personal phone and submit them to the Team Leader at the end of each day
- Support camper check-in and check-out procedures and assist with attendance tracking as directed
- Assist with distribution of take-home items including PCs, USB keys, T-shirts, headphones, and certificates
- Participate in Thursday field trips, Friday Game Days, and all special camp events including the 20th Anniversary Hai Hai BBQ
- Participate fully in the Train-the-Trainer staff development week (July 20–24) and apply learnings throughout the program
- Report any participant concerns, behavioural issues, or safety matters promptly to the Team Leader

- Cultural sensitivity and respect for Cree traditions, protocols, and family values
